FONTAGRO is a unique cooperation mechanism for agricultural innovation in Latin America and the Caribbean and operates through regional platforms. It consists of 15 countries that have contributed capital in excess of \$100 million and is sponsored by the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) and the Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture (IICA).

Governance structure

A Board of Directors (BoD) with representation from member countries and a Technical and Administrative Secretariat (TAS).

Mission

FONTAGRO's mission is to contribute to increasing the competitiveness of the agricultural sector, to poverty reduction and to the sustainable management of natural resources in the region. FONTAGRO also functions as a discussion forum on agricultural and rural innovation.

- Technological, organizational and institutional innovation.
- Adaptation to and mitigation of climate change.

- Competitive territories and value chains.

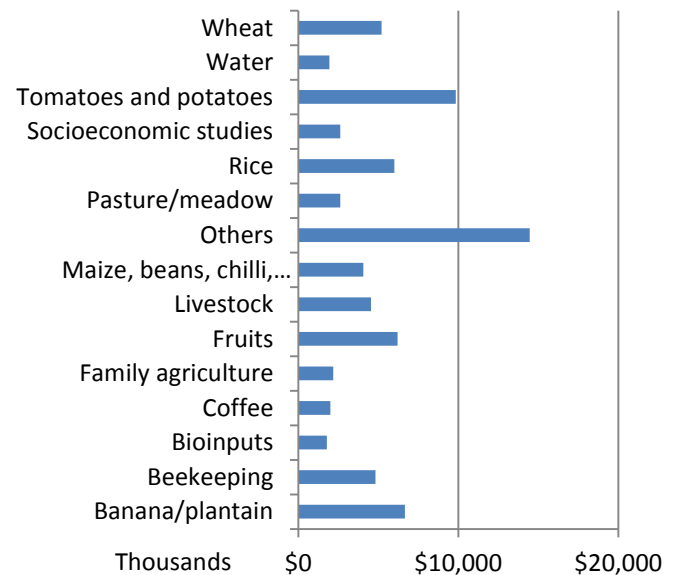

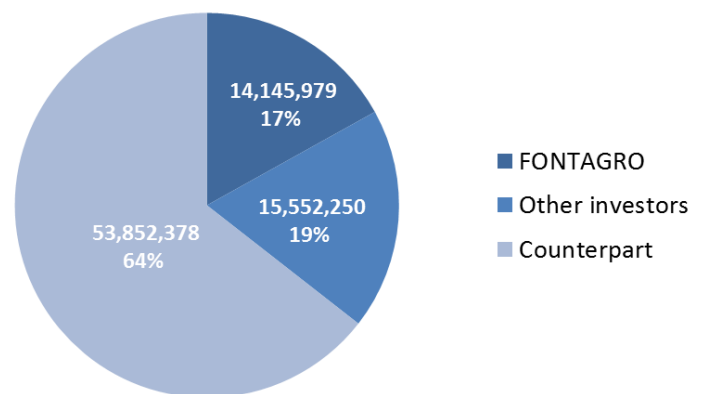

Allocation of funds by innovation field

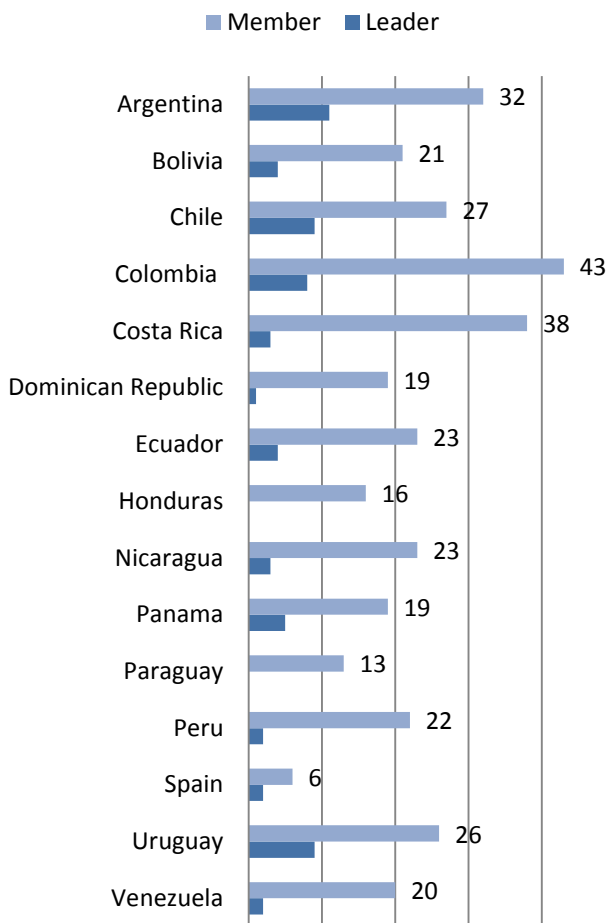

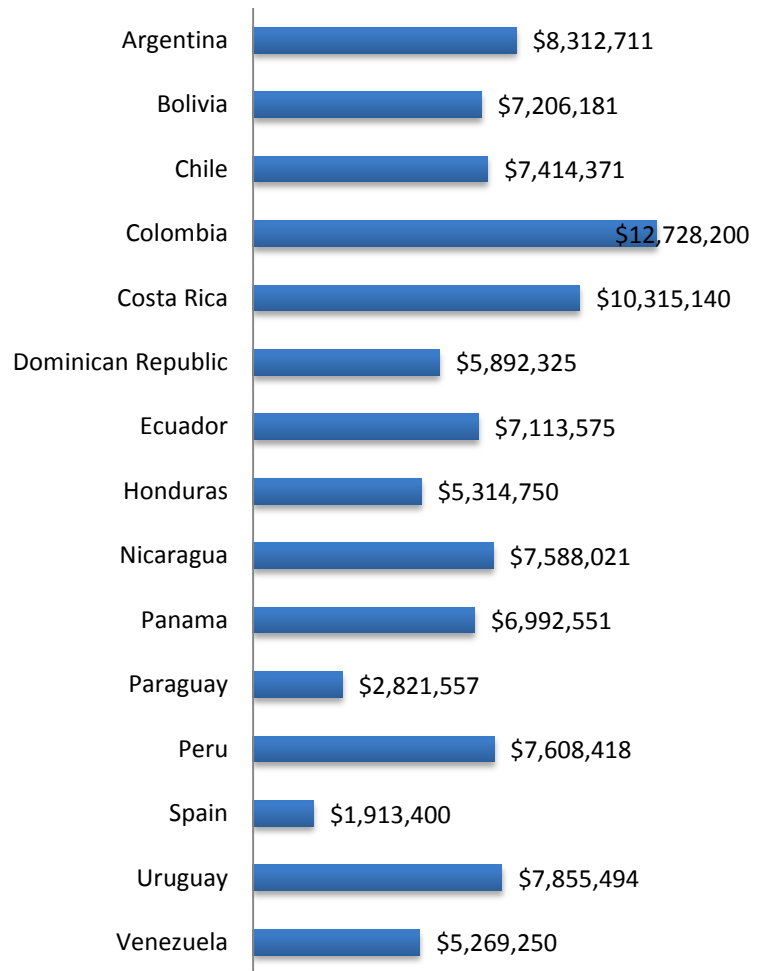


Platform participation and role 1998-2016
